



Four questions to ask before you purchase an air conditioner

This quick reference guide provides you with important questions to ask to ensure you select the right air conditioner for your needs, and that it is installed legally and correctly.

Checklist

IMPORTANT QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE YOU BUY A NEW AIR CONDITIONER:



Make sure you discuss which air conditioner will best suit the layout of your house.

Think about influencing factors like insulation, windows and number of rooms you want cooled.



Ask if the air conditioning system's kW size is the right capacity for your needs.

This could save you a lot of money in the long run.



Ask how energy efficient the air conditioner is.

This should be displayed on the **star energy rating label** on the product.



Discuss installation with your sales representative.

Ask if their installers are appropriately licensed through the ARC. If they do not have installers, you can find licensed technicians at **www.lookforthetick.com.au** Never DIY install a fluorocarbon-gas air conditioner. Only licensed technicians can legally install and service fluorocarbon-gas air conditioners.
